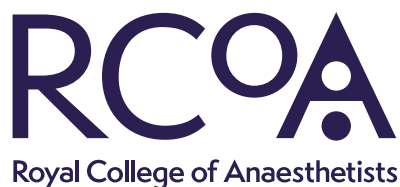


# Annual General Meeting 2021
